National Action Alliance for Suicide Prevention

- Established in 2012
- Public/Private partnership (each has a chair)
- Goal is to save 20,000 lives over the next 5 years
- Working to advance the “National Strategy for Suicide Prevention”
- Integrate suicide prevention into healthcare reform and encourage the adoption of similar measures in the private sector.
- Transform healthcare systems to significantly reduce suicide.
- Change the public conversation about suicide and suicide prevention.
- Increase the quality, timeliness, and usefulness of surveillance data regarding suicide behavior.

American Foundation for Suicide Prevention

- Established in 1987
- Leading national not-for-profit dedicated to understanding and preventing suicide
- Research, education, and advocacy
