## HUMAN ANIMAL INTERACTION

"Such a long term relationship, as in the case of PTSD service dogs that live with their person, provides the possibility of establishing a secure attachment."
"Anecdotal reports, which includes the veterans in the training of service dogs, include improvements in patience, impulse control, emotion regulation, sleep, depression, sense of purpose, and more.'


## SERVICEDOG

IMPROVEMENT IN SYMPTOMS

1. Hypervigilance...block maneuvers
2. Night terrors...Wake up
3. Fear...house sweeps first, turn on lights
4. Avoidnce/Isolation...out in public again. Relating again positively
5. Memory...reminder to take meds.
6. Support system of love and trust.

## FRONT BLOCK

Skill to prevent anyone from approaching
Used for alert/calm


## REAR BLOCK

## GOT YOUR BACK

Used to prevent anyone from approaching
Calm/ hyper/mall
Not used for others



## CHALLENGES/LESSONSLEARNED

1. THE MORE ADMIN SUPPORT, THE BETTER. MAY NEED POLICY CHANGE OR CREATION.
2. LACK OF UNDERSTANDING OF THERAPY DOGS, SERVICE DOGS AND WHY THEY CAN BE USED.
3. DIFFERENT TRAINING STYLE THAN WHAT DEPT. USED TO
4. MISINTERPRETING WHAT THEY ARE SEEING, CANINE BEHAVIOR.
5. HANDLERS MUST COMMIT TO ONGOING K9 TRAINING AND HUMAN TRAINING. ( CISM, ASIST)
6. VOLUNTEER FD TEAM.
7. CAN'T BE A PROPHET IN YOUR OWN LAND, DON'T GET DISCOURAGED PIVOT TO GREEN LIGHTS
8. GET CERTIFIED IF APPROPRIATE AND TRAIN BOTH CANINES AND PEOPLE.
9. USING TRAINERS, IF NOT, BECOME ONE.
